

At Eternal Paws we strive to meet or exceed customer expectations. One of our primary goals is to have systems in place that prevent any mix ups and insure that each pet owner receives their own pets remains back. We consider it a privilege to partner with the very best veterinary clinics around and will do our part in each situation to make sure that your clinic and Eternal Paws are represented with high regard. Below are a few pointers to help us all be the best we can at what we do, care for pets.

- 1) We provide marketing materials encouraging pet owners to plan for cremation ahead of time. Our hope is to make it an easier time for the pet, the owner, and you. You are welcome to show them the provided pictures of the urn packages or send them to our website to view the options as well. Having a plan prior to euthanasia is helpful for everyone. We don't offer euthanasia services, only cremation.
- 2) Insure private cremations are properly identified. Record ID tag number on carbon order form and manila colored paper body bag tag. Place metal ID tag on pets FRONT paw, close to their paw pads, NOT up high on their leg. This prevents the tag from being frozen under their leg and helps us insure ID numbers match paperwork before cremation.
- 3) Please remove ALL clothing, collars, catheters and any toys or blankets. We are not permitted to have anything in the incinerator but pets. Removing these items from frozen bodies is often not possible without thawing the body out first. Metal pieces from collars or clothes, etc. get caught in the processor blades which is expensive to repair.
- 4) For custom urns that require pictures: a digital copy is best. They can email the picture to info@eternalpawslc.com please include the pets name and the clinic name. Keep the file original size rather than allowing the computer to send a smaller file.
- 5) Blue paper bag tags are for communal cremations. Pet owners will not receive remains back, no metal ID tags are used, and we don't offer clay paw prints for communal cremations. We offer communal cremation as a dignified option to the veterinary offices whom we serve on a regular basis and are picked with private cremations.
- 6) If the client wants a clay paw print for a private cremation, please make sure it is checked off on the carbon order form and the manila paper body bag tag.
- 7) When placing the body bag tag on the outside of the bag please make sure that the wires are securely tied to the bag, so it doesn't blow or fall off.
- 8) Engraved name plates will have the pets name on them unless something else is indicated inside the box on the order form. They will be ordered exactly how it is written on the order form.
